The National Seminar

Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 was enacted by the Parliament on 14th Dec, 2016. It was notified on 28th December, 2016 replacing the Persons with Disability (PwD) Act of 1995. The Act attracts the attention of researchers, practitioners and stakeholders as the number of disabilities has increased from seven in PwD Act (1995) to twenty one in RPwD Act, 2016. Discussions and deliberations are going on the implementation aspects of the Act. The Act covers the issues namely social security, barrier free health care, free education for children with benchmark disabilities, reservation in higher educational institutes, special employment schemes etc. The implementation of the Act emphasizes on new role and responsibilities of teachers teaching at school, college and university level and the Act stipulates that their work competencies can be enhanced in inclusive settings. In the light of this Act, the higher learning institutes, technical institutes and other stake-holders have to work out for building the

capacity of the students, scholars and rehabilitation practitioners so that they can facilitate new strategies and draw out plan for its effective implementation in comprehensive manner for the welfare of the disabled persons as a matter of their right.

Objectives

The seminar intends to achieve the following objectives:

- i. To acquaint the participants about the main features of the RPwD Act.
- ii. To discuss the problems faced by the stakeholders in the implementation of the Act.
- iii. To provide a forum to participants to share experiences and expertise as curriculum planners, executers and evaluators in the light of RPwD Act.
- iv. To suggest modifications, if any, in the light of experiences shared by the participants with reference to model curriculum developed by RCI for teacher education courses.

- Cite references in APA style.
- Participants can either present the paper orally or through power point.
- Coauthored papers should indicate the main author and the presenter.
- In case of joint presentation, author and the co-author(s) have to register individually.
- Plagiarism is strictly denounced, if found at any stage then the Author(s) will be solely responsible.
