
ORDINANCE: FOUR-YEAR INTEGRATED PROGRAMME IN TEACHER
EDUCATION LEADING TO THE DEGREE OF B.A. /B. Sc. /B.Com. B. Ed.

1. The duration of the course leading to the degree of B.A. /B.Sc. /B.Com. B.Ed. shall be four years. The examination shall be held twice in a year according to the semester system and as per the schedule fixed by the Vice-Chancellor. A supplementary examination will be held as per the schedule and dates fixed by the Vice-Chancellor.
2. The last date of receipt of examination forms and fee shall be fixed by the Vice-Chancellor from time to time.
3. The minimum qualifications for admission to the first year of the course shall be:-
Senior Secondary Examination(10+2) of CBSE or Board of School Education Haryana, Bhiwani or an equivalent examination recognized by this University with 60% marks in any stream (Science/ Arts/ Commerce stream); selection will be made on merit through entrance test with reservation as per University / State Government policy.
4. A student who possesses the qualification laid down in clause 3 above and produces the following certificates signed by the head of concerned institution and who fulfills the following conditions shall be eligible to appear in examination :-
 - 1) has been on the roles of the institution during the academic year preceding the examination ;
 - 2) His/her name is submitted to the Registrar/ Controller of examination by the head of the institution provided that the candidate:
 - a) Possesses good character
 - b) Has undergone four-year integrated programme in teacher education leading to the degree of B.A. /B.Sc. /B.Com. B.Ed. in the recognized institution.
 - c) Has attended not less than 75% of the lectures delivered in each subject in theory and practical separately. Relaxation in shortage of lectures up to 20% will be allowed by the Principal/ Head on the following grounds:
 - i) Self-illness
 - ii) Illness/death of parents, brother, sister or any other close family member



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- iii) Any other reason beyond the control of the student to the satisfaction of the Principal of the concerned institution.
 - d) Has obtained not less than 25% marks in the aggregate of all the subjects calculated on the basis of result of the following:
 - i) House examination (in theory papers only)
 - ii) two class test (in theory papers only)
5. The amount of examination fee to be paid by the candidate for each semester shall be prescribed by the University from time to time.
 6. The examination shall be held according to the syllabus approved by the University.
 7. The medium of instructions in the examination shall be English and Hindi except for languages.
 8. The minimum number of marks required to pass the examination shall be 40% in each theory paper, practical, and in the aggregate.
 9. i) A candidate who fails to pass or having been eligible but fails to appear in any semester examination will be allowed to clear the re-appear paper(s) within a period of twelve semesters, and sit for a maximum of three exams per paper. For papers of liberal options improvement of result after passing a semester examination will be permissible within a period of twelve semesters. While re-appearing to pass a semester examination, the candidate will be exempted from re-appearing in the practicum (practical) papers in which he/she has secured 40% marks.
 - ii) The candidate shall be promoted to the next semester/ class automatically subject to fulfilment of conditions as prescribed in clause 4 above.
 10. The internal assessment awards as well as viva-voce awards of a candidate who fails in any semester examination shall be carried forward to the next examination.
 11. The Registrar/ Controller, of Examinations shall publish the result of examination after the completion of examination or as early as possible.
 12. Successful candidates shall be classified as under:

a) 60% marks and above	First division
b) 50% marks and above but below 60%	Second Division
c) Below 50%	Third Division


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13. Each successful candidate shall be awarded a degree stating the division obtained.
14. A candidate obtaining not less than 40% marks in aggregate and failed in one paper only shall be promoted to the next semester. However, if the candidate does not clear the re-appear paper of the lower semester even in the second chance, his promotion to the next higher semester will be stopped till he/she clears the said re-appear paper.
15. If a candidate fails in the school Internship in Teaching or is unable to complete internship in teaching but passes in all other subjects he/she will be required to repeat the complete 'internship in Teaching' in the next academic session along with regular candidates.
16. After passing the four year integrated programme for teacher education the candidate will be awarded the degree of B.A./B.Sc./B.Com. and B.Ed. The candidate will be eligible for the admission to higher studies i.e. M.A. /M.Sc. /M.Com. /M.Ed. etc. This degree will be considered as equivalent to B.A. / B.Sc./B.Com. and B.Ed. as the case may be.
17. Notwithstanding the integrated nature of the course which is spread over more than four academic years, the Ordinance in force at the time a student joins the course shall hold good only for the examination held during or at the end of that academic year and nothing in this Ordinance shall be deemed to debar the University from amending the Ordinance and the a amended Ordinance, if any, shall apply to all students, whether old or new.


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
