6. Planning on placement/Carrier Counseling/Subject specific skill development.

RESOLUTION: One Independent Communication Skill lab may be established and one period may be assigned for each class.

The Board also resolved that one subject on current affairs of one credit may be started.

7. Alumni meet.

RESOLUTION: At least one Alumni meet in a year may be organized at University level.

8. Academic/Development/Extension activities.

RESOLUTION: A schedule may be drafted for Academic/Development/Extension activities.

9. Human Resource Planning.

RESOLUTION: Human resource of the University need to be urgently strengthened. Hence, process of recruitment should be rigorously carried out. Also we should ensure quality in faculty recruitment.

10. Resource Sharing/Collaboration/MoUs etc.

RESOLUTION: Resources in research labs are costly and scarce. Hence, there is a need for sharing resources amongst different universities/institutions.

The proposals for starting of Skill Courses of short duration as received from Dean Academic Affairs on recommendation of various Chairpersons/Incharges of University Teaching Departments (Annexure-III, Pages 9 to 13, already circulated). RESOLUTION: The following Skill Courses may be started:
 - (a) 2 months Skill Based Certificate Course on Entrepreneurship and Communication Skills (Department of Management).
 - (b) Skill based certificate course-Photography, Cinematography and Video Editing (Department of Mass Communication).
 - (c) Certificate Course on 'Personality Development' (Department of Psychology).

Introduction to the above agenda items, the following general observations/suggestions were also given by the Hon'ble Members of the Academic Planning Board:

- b) A subject or course on Defense Studies may also be taken up by the University.

2. Dr. N.P. Singh:

- a) All academic and curriculum activities of the University should be NAAC oriented.
- b) Three/Six Months Certificate Courses as an Add on courses may be started, for example; A course in Security Management, GST etc.

3. Prof. Rambaksh:

- a) UGC fully finances M.A. Hindi course which should be explored.
- b) University should adopt E-learning/Mooc Courses.
- c) University should ensure quality in its recruitment for teaching faculty.

4. Dr. Dharamdev Vidyarthi:

- University should start Career Coaching. Also it should have its own Swimming Pool as youth of this area has huge potential
- b) University should work on Vedic Culture and Haryanvi Culture.
- c) University Website should be updated regularly.
- d) Teacher should e-teacher diary.

5. Prof. R.K. Sharma:

- a) University should carefully use social media marketing.
- b) To improve quality of delivery; class room's activity based/engagement mode of learning should be adopted.
- c) Academic penalty for students may be thought of
- d) LOTS/HOTS question paper to be explored

6. Col. M.S. Dahiya:

- a) To make the students employment ready training in Computer Efficiency, lingual transformation, accent neutralization is necessary for all students of the University.
- b) Courses/training on beyond academics should be part of the main curriculum for example; life skills, soft skill etc.
