About the University Chaudhary Ranbir Singh University, Jind, was established by the State Legislature Act 28 of 2014 on July 24, 2014. It has a spreading Campus of 75 acres situated nearly 2 kilometers away from Jind-Gohana and Jind-Rohtak Bypass. At the initial stage, it was started as a Post Graduate Regional Center by K.U. Kurukshetra in 2007. Aim of the University is the cultivation of citizens with a rich awareness of our heritage to lead and serve in every sphere of human activity. Working under the leadership of eminent educationists and social reformers, Hon'ble Chancellor Prof. Kaptan Singh Solanki and dedicated, dynamic and devoted personality Vice- Chancellor Prof. R. B. Solanki, the University is heading towards realization of its vision and the goal of being in the world ranking by 2020.

The University is affiliated u/s 2(f) of the UGC Act, 1956 vide letter no. 9-12/2014(CPP-I/PU) Dated 26 September, 2014 and is also a member of the Association of Indian Universities. In addition, the team of UGC has also visited on 12-13 July, 2017 to inspect the requirement of 12 (B) of UGC Act, 1956.

The University has a newly constructed academic block with latest infrastructure and newly constructed Laxmi Bai Girls Hostel with ultra modern facilities. The University has a central Library with a stock of approximately 15000 books. It also subscribes to National and International refereed Journals, Magazines and Periodicals and also subscribes many Hindi and English news papers for intellectual development of the students. The University has an impressive Language Lab, Computer lab well equipped with the latest software, and Psychology lab fully equipped with latest Psychological apparatus and tests.

To enhance the research activities for the holistic development of the students and researchers, the University has organised 01 International Seminar, 01 International Conference, 03 National Seminars and 02 National Workshop. In addition to the academics the students are also encouraged to participate in sports events and extracurricular activities at the campus as well as outside to campus the enable their wholesome personality development.

About the Department of Psychology: The Department of Psychology was established in 2012 when it was under the Postgraduate Regional Center, Jind, K.U. Kurukshetra. At the initial stage, intake of the department was 20. In July, 2014, the Postgraduate Regional Center was upgraded to become a university. Department of Psychology has increased its intake 50 and running two years master degree. The department of Psychology having its advanced Psychological Testing, Experimental and Biofeedback labs along with standardized and latest versions of Equipments and Tests. The Department running different job orientated optional papers like Clinical Psychology, Guidance and Counseling, Cognitive Psychology, Personality Psychology, and Child Psychology. Department of Psychology has also organized a one sponsored seminar and two seven day workshop. In view of the future, department is planning to start diploma/certificate courses, and M. Phil. and Ph. D. research programmers. In continuation, the Department is also thrust to enhance the excellence in research and academic, through empirical and studies based on real social issues.

About the Workshop: The workshop is finalized to achieve the two objectives. Firstly, it will emphasize the basic understanding and importance of psychological testing. Second, it will highlight some uncovered social and practical issues through exploration of the applications of psychological testing. In this regard, four sessions consisting of **Personality Assessment**, **Assessment of Mental Abilities**, **Projective Techniques**, and **Neuropsychological Assessment** will be done through demonstration of tests and batteries. It will be helpful to research scholars, practitioners and academicians to understand the selection of research problems as well as the abnormal behaviors in concerned discipline.
