Code of Conduct for District Youth Parliament

- 1. All the Participants will stay in the house for full sessions.
- 2. Display of any political symbol is not to be accompanied.
- 3. Political slogan / statement in between the discourse are not allowed.
- Dress Code for Male Participants will be Kurta Pajama / Dhoti Kurta / Shirt and Trouser (Not Jeans) with Sweater / Jacket / Coat
- Dress Code for Female Participants will be Salwar Kameej / Sari with Sweater / Jacket / Coat
- 6. Participants have to listen the talk of other participants without making a noise.
- 7. Audience will sit only in audience hall.
- 8. Unauthorized entry in Parliament Hall is Strictly Prohibited.
- 9. Smoking is Strictly Prohibited.
- 10. Any person who has consumed liquor or any other intoxicating material will not be allowed in youth parliament hall or audience hall. If found, a strict action will be taken against such person.
- 11. It is mandatory for all participants, jury and other dignitaries to follow the code of conduct impound by Election Commission of India in view of by-election in Jind legislative constituency. The person violating the code of conduct will personally be liable for legal or service actions. The organisers will not be responsible for such personal acts.
