THE UNIVERSITY

The University was established by the Haryana State Legislature Act 28 of 2014 on 24th July 2014. Under the dynamic and enterprising leadership of Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor, Prof. R.B. Solanki, the University not only provides a participatory academic environment to its students but also strives hard to develop its neighbour community through social outreach programmes. The university endeavours to contribute towards the multi-dimensional growth of the region in general and the holistic development of the students in particular.

DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION

The Department of Education is one of the leading and rapidly growing Departments of CRS University. It offers two full-time courses in Education viz. M.A.(Education) and Ph.D. The Department has academically rich faculty members credited with Ph.D. and publications in reputed national and international journals. In the near future, the Department is planning to start the ITEP (four years integrated) programme for which the State Govt. of Haryana has provided its recommendations to NCTE. The Department offers a wide range of activities like lectures, seminars and group discussions to enhance the skills of the students. Extension lectures are a regular feature of the Department.

NIEPVD

The National Institute for the Empowerment of Persons with Visual Disabilities (NIEPVD) owes its origin to St. Dunstan's Hostel for the War Blind established in 1943. In 1950, the Government of India took over the St. Dunstan's Hostel and established there a Training Centre for the Adult Blind. In 1951, the Government established Central Braille Press on its campus. Subsequently, various institutions viz. workshop for the manufacturing of Braille Appliances, Training Centre for the Adult Blind Women, School for the Visually Handicapped, and National Library for the Print Handicapped came into being. In 1967, the Government established the National Center for the Blind (NCB).

This Centre was further upgraded as National Institute for the Visual Handicapped in the year 1979, and in 1982, it was registered under the Societies Registration Act, 1860 and gained the status of an Autonomous Body. The National Institute for the Visual Handicapped was renamed as the National Institute for the Empowerment of Persons with Visual Disabilities (NIEPVD) by the Government of India in 2018. The institute offers varied services for persons with visual impairments including education, empowerment and rehabilitation. The D.Ed., B.Ed. and M.Ed. course runs on its campus are recognised by the Rehabilitation Council of India.

TRAINING PROGRAMME

The main objective of the training programme is to reorient professionals in the field of education of persons with disabilities about the concept of cross-disability and inclusion. It is expected that the participants will renovate their experiences, refresh the knowledge and benefit from the experiences of others and acquire new information in this emerging area. The training has been planned to achieve the following specific objectives:

1. Developing an understanding of philosophy and perspectives on inclusive education.
2. Deliberating on contemporary developments in cross-disability and inclusion.
3. Providing training on how to execute concept of universal design in inclusive schools.
4. Enabling the participants to identify the problems in the area of cross-disability and resolve them locally.

The participants of the training will include teachers from Colleges and University teaching departments; general teachers, special educators, principals and managers of inclusive schools; para-professionals and social workers in the field of special and inclusive education.

REGISTRATION

The Rehabilitation Council of India, New Delhi has accorded CRE status to the training programme for 100 participants. The interested candidates are required to get registered by paying Rs. 1200/- through a demand draft drawn in favour of 'Director NIVH, Dehradun' up to 5th December 2019. The delegates will be invited and registered for participation on a first-cum-first serve basis. Certificates with CRE Status will be issued to each registered participant after the completion of training.
