The Director Higher Education, Haryana Panchkula, vide memo no. 20/9-2014 UNP (1) date 22.6.16, notified that all B.P.Ed., M.P.Ed and Diploma in D.P.Ed. etc. courses approved by NCTE and are presently running in Education Colleges will also be affiliated to Chaudhary Ranbir Singh University, Jind from the Session 2016-17 as college cannot be affiliated to two different Universities for different course being running in a college. The Education College is running MPES, BPES etc. which are approved by the UGC, New Delhi, the same will also be affiliated to Chaudhary Ranbir Singh University, Jind subject to further approval by the Director Higher Education, Haryana Panchkula.


Accordingly, the University has finalized the following schedule of admission for Colleges of Education running the MPES, BPES courses:

Opening date of admission **June 29, 2016**

Closing date of admission **July 29, 2016**

The candidate has to qualify Physical Efficiency Test (Canadian Test) for Physical Education courses. The Chairperson, Dept. of Physical Education, CRSU Jind or his nominee will present at the time of Physical Efficiency Test. Each college will intimate the date of Physical Efficiency Test in advance to the Chairperson, Department of Physical Education, CRSU Jind (01681-241005, +91-9812943445, chphysicaleducation@crsu.ac.in).



Subject: Eligibility for admission to BPES and MPES

The following is the eligibility criteria for **BPES and MPES** being run in Education Colleges:

MPES (2 Years)

Eligibility: (i) Educational Qualification

Bachelor of Physical Education (B.P.Ed) or equivalent with at least 45% marks.

OR

Bachelor of Science (B.Sc.) in Health and Physical Education/BPE/BPES with at least 45% marks.

(ii) Physical Efficiency Test

All the eligible candidates will be required to qualify the Physical Efficiency Test (PET). However, the criteria and the specifications of the individual events of the Canadian Test will be decided by the Department of Physical Education CRSU Jind.


Note:

- (i) Married female selected candidates will have to submit a certificate from SMO/MO of the Civil Hospital that she is not in family way, along with an undertaking that if during the course of study, it is found that she is in family way, her admission would be liable to be **cancelled IPSO-FACTO and all dues paid by her shall be forfeited.**
- (ii) Every student (Male and Female) will submit medical fitness certificate at the time of admission. No excuse for physical activity during the course will be entertained.

B.P.E.S. (2 Years)

Eligibility:

- (i) **Educational Qualification** Senior Secondary School (+2) or its equivalent examination passed with atleast 50% marks. However 5% relaxation be given to those who have participated in International/National/SGFI sports competitions.
- (ii) No Sports/Game certificate will be considered for weightage without its Gradation issued from the Director, Sports and Youth Welfare of the State concerned. In the Sports/Games where no Gradation Certificate is being issued by the concerned State/U.T. in such cases the certificate must be verified by the concerned Director, Sports of the State/U.T., the certificate


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issued by the Federation alone will not be considered. Further for inter college/inter university certificates of such games/ sports a gradation/verification certificate issued by the Director, Sports of the University concerned will be considered.

Note:- Certificates of sports and games organized by the Nehru Yuvak Kendra, Women Sports Festivals, Rural Games and Sports Festivals, Panchayats, and Invitation Tournaments will not be considered.

- (iii) **Physical Efficiency Test:** All the eligible candidates will be required to qualify the Physical Efficiency Test (PET). However, the criteria and the specifications of the individual events of the Canadian Test will be decided by the Department of Physical Education, CRSU Jind.

Note:


- (i) Married female selected candidates will have to submit a certificate from SMO/MO of the Civil Hospital that she is not in family way, along with an undertaking that if during the course of study, it is found that she is in family way, her admission would be liable to be **cancelled IPSO-FACTO and all dues paid by her shall be forfeited.**
- (ii) Every student (Male and Female) will submit medical fitness certificate at the time of admission. No excuse for physical activity during the course will be entertained.

WEIGHTAGES FOR THE PURPOSE OF MERIT

(A)	Candidates who have passed the qualifying exam. From universities in Haryana State.	5 marks
(B)	Recipients of National Talent Award from the NCERT	5 marks
(C)	Candidates who have secured 60% marks/CGPA 6.0 on 10 point scale from First Public Examination to Qualifying Examination.	5 marks
(D)	Candidates who have passed Honors Examination in the subject concerned	5 marks
(E)	N.C.C. Cadets who have passed the 'B' Certificate and N.C.C. Cadets who have passed 'C' or 'G-II' Certificate (No weightage will be given for civil defence service) Note: If NCC cadets have both 'B' and 'C' Certificates maximum Weightage of 5 marks will be given. OR Students who have been recommended or commended (i.e. have obtained 1 st or 2 nd position) at the Inter-Zonal or Inter-University or Inter-State Level Youth Festival(s) or competition(s) organized by State Govt./University either individually or as members of a team. OR Holder of Certificate of Merit for N.S.S. awarded by the University.	3 marks 5 marks

Criteria for award of University N.S.S. Merit Certificate are as follows

1. N.S.S Volunteer who has completed 240 hours of regular activities in the period of two years and attended two annual special Camps (of atleast 10 days duration).


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2. One who has donated blood atleast twice **OR** has made atleast five illiterates literate. This shall have to be certified by the Principal along with the names and addresses of literates. **OR** one who has done an exemplary act of courage or bravery by saving life in situations like drowning, fire, natural calamities **OR** man made calamities and awarded at the National Level.

In case of NSS Volunteers from other Universities located outside Haryana, one has to become eligible by way of becoming at par with the conditions as required under Sr. No. 1 and 2 of the above criteria laid down for University Merit Certificate and NSS weightage will not be allowed to the students who have only NSS participation certificate given by the College Principal.

Note: For allowing weightage to NSS and Sports, certificate should be got verified from the officer of the concerned Department.

(ii)	Winning 1 st position in National/All India Inter State/All India Inter-varsity ;	15 marks
(iii)	Winning 2 nd position in National or All India Inter State-All India Inter-varsity;	13 marks
(iv)	Winning 3 rd position in National/All India Inter State/All India Inter-varsity;	11 marks
(v)	Winning 1 st position in North/South/East/West Zone Inter-varsity or any zone;	08 marks
(vi)	Winning 2 nd position in North/South/East/West Zone Inter-varsity or any zone;	07 marks
(vii)	Winning 3 rd position in North/South/East/West Zone Inter-varsity or any zone;	06 marks
(viii)	Participation in Inter-University/National (only for B.P.Ed.);	03 marks
(ix)	NIS Diploma in Game and Sports/Diploma in Yoga from a recognized Institution.	05 marks

Guidelines for weightage(s)

- (1) Besides the one maximum higher weightage mentioned at Sr. No.(F) (i) to (viii) and weightage at Sr. No. (ix) and only one weightage of the remaining categories under Clause (A) to (E) of Section-V would be added for the purpose of merit for admission to D.P.Ed., B.P.Ed., M.P.Ed. , BPES and MPES courses. -
- (2) Sports certificate for admission to D.P.Ed., B.P.Ed., M.P.Ed. , BPES and MPES will only be considered if the candidate produces the gradation certificate from the respective Govt. in respect of the games/sports for which the candidate claims sports weightage & eligibility.

In case any State does not issue the Gradation Certificate, the following criteria will be adopted for accepting the Sports Certificate for admission to D.P.Ed., B.P.Ed., M.P.Ed. , BPES and MPES:


- (i) In case of District Position holder, a certificate of authenticity from the concerned District Association/Federation duly countersigned by the District Sports Officer will be accepted.
- (ii) In case of State Position holder, National Participation, National Position holder & International level a certificate of authenticity from concerned State Association/Federation duly countersigned by the Director of Sports of the State will be accepted.
- (iii) In case of Inter Collegiate and All India Inter-Varsity position holders the certificate will be verified from the Director of Sports of the concerned.


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- (3) The position at National Level will only be considered if the candidate has participated in Inter-Collegiate Tournaments/ State Level Tournament in the same game/event during college period.
- (4) Weightage for the purpose of merit under Clause (E) Section V will be given only if the candidate has obtained required Certificates/Distinction during the course of the qualifying examination on the basis of which he is seeking admission to the course concerned.
- (5) Weightage/eligibility for sports/games will only be given to those sports/games which are recognized by the Association of Indian Universities. Current list of such sports/games recognized by AIU is as under:

Games for Men and Women:

American Football, Aquatics, Archery, Athletics, Ball Badminton, Baseball, Boxing, Canoeing and Kayaking, Circle Style Kabaddi, Cross Country Races, Cycling Road, Cycling Track, Fencing, Gatka, Gymnastics & Malkhamb, Hockey 5's, Judo , Korf Ball, Netball, Pistol Shooting & .177, Air Rifle Peep Sight, Clay Pigeon Shooting Trap, Double Trap and Skeet, Power Lifting, Roll Ball, Rowing, Sepak Takraw, , Soft Tennis, Softball,, Squash Rackets, Taekwondo, Tug of War, Wrestling Free Style, Greco Roman Style Wrestling, Wt. Lifting and Best Physique , Wushu, Yachting, Yoga, Badminton, Basketball, Chess, Cricket, Football, Handball, Hockey, Kabaddi, Kho-Kho, Table-Tennis, Tennis, Volleyball


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
