**General Instructions**

2. The entire examination process may be observed by the university through observers. The observers may verify the identity of the examiners and candidates during the examination. The TA / DA and remuneration to the observers will be paid by the University directly and not by the college.
3. The examiners shall ensure that examination is conducted strictly in accordance with the instructions /rules /regulations/notifications issued by CRSU Jind from time to time. The Examiners should also verify the identity of examinee by matching the particulars of examinee in the attendance chart and Aadhar Card/ Voter Card/ Driving License or PAN Card carried by him / her.
4. The examination shall be conducted in the college premises only at the scheduled time and date. The change in examination schedule shall not be done without prior permission of controller of examination. Each examiner shall bring a identity of himself/herself issued by a govt. office along with his/her identity card issued by his/her employer. In case, the employer has not issued an I-Card, the concerned examiner shall bring a letter affixed with photo from the employer.
5. No. Examiner should be replaced without prior permission of Controller of Examinations, CRSU Jind.
6. The College principal shall ensure adequate facilities for the examiners to conduct the examination in smooth manner and provide internet facilities to upload the examination marks /outcome on website portal of the concerned college immediately after the conclusion of the examination on the same day.
7. The examiners shall be paid remuneration along with T.A/D.A as per CRSU Norms on the spot by the college. In case, the examination is scheduled for more than one day in succession, the concerned college shall provide/arrange accommodation to the examiner as per his/her entitlement. The CRSU shall reimburse the expenses incurred on payment of remuneration along with T.A/D.A and accommodation charges. The College must submit a bill for reimbursement of the above amount to the university controller of examination within 15 days from termination of examination and after lapse of these 15 days, the concerned college shall

be responsible for delay in reimbursement and the same may also be denied by the university. In case of any excess payment, the concerned college shall be responsible and the university shall not reimburse the excess amount. The examiners shall be entitled for double remuneration on any public holiday and vacations notified by CRSU for B.Ed. course.

8. Generally one Examiner will not do more than 100 evaluations in a single day.
9. In case, a college administration approaches the examiner for any favor, the strict action shall be initiated under the law.
10. The examinee shall appear at the examination center at least 30 minutes before the start of examination.
11. Each examinee shall bring an identity issued by a govt. office (Adhhar card, voting I card, driving license tec.).
12. No candidate shall approach the examiner with any cash or kind for any favor in the examination. In case a candidate is found engaged in the above practice, strict action shall be initiated against the candidate including debarring from the examination.
