



NOTIFICATION REGARDING CONDUCT OF EXAMINATIONS

The Vice-Chancellor, on the recommendation of the committee constituted for conduct of examinations for various courses being run in University Teaching Departments and Affiliated College for the Academic session 2019-20 as per UGC report of April, 2020 in view of Covid-19 Pandemic and subsequent lockdown, has approved the following in anticipation of Academic Council and subjected to modification By Haryana Government / UGC (if any):

1. The theory examination of the terminal semester / year will be conducted in July-2020
2. The practical examination of terminal semester / year will be conducted after completion of theory examinations.
3. The reappear examination of students studying in terminal semester / year will be conducted after completion of regular theory examinations.
4. The examination of courses run by education colleges will be conducted in August-2020.
5. Due to Covid-19 Pandemic, the students are required to attempt any five questions out of eight or nine questions instead of unit wise choice/compulsory question as enforced by ordinances of respective courses. This relaxation will be one time and for regular students only.
6. The students who are studying in intermediate semester / year will be promoted provisionally to the next semester / year subject to passing the respective examinations to be conducted by the University in near future.
7. The examination form by students of UTDs and affiliated colleges except education colleges will be filled as per following schedule:
 - i. With normal fee up to 5th June, 2020
 - ii. With late fee of 500 up to 12th June, 2020
 - iii. With late fee of Rs. 1000 up to 19th June, 2020
8. The Superintendent in Chief / Center Superintendent shall take care of social distancing and using of mask during the examination.

9. The sitting plan in theory examination shall be prepared in such a manner, that a distance of 6' (six feet) can be maintained between two students. Therefore one Invigilator / Assistant Superintendent can be appointed on every 15-20 students. Similarly, the practical examinations can be conducted in group of 15-20 students by maintaining social distance.
10. The spaces used for examinations are to be sanitized before every exam.
11. Wearing of masks by every student as well as staff on examination duty is mandatory.
12. The students are advised to carry drinking water and hand sanitizer with him/her.
13. Any other SOP issued by Government for prevention of COVID-19.
