THE MINUTES OF THE MEETING ARE AS UNDER:

1. Confirmed the minutes of the last meeting held on 21st August, 2019 circulated vide letter No. CRSU/Acad./AC-12/Minutes/S-I/2019/6643-56 dated 04.09.2019.

Resolved that the minutes of the 12th meeting of Academic Council be confirmed except Resolution Nos. 6, 8, 16, 36 and 44.

2. Reported the Action taken, wherever required on the various decisions taken by the Academic Council in its 12th meeting held on 21st August, 2019 for information and suggestions, if any.

While noting the follow up action taken report on the decisions of 12th meeting of Academic Council, Members of the Academic Council have pointed out on the following resolutions and added as under with the permission of the Chair:-

Resolution No. 6: Syllabus of each course must be changed after a gap of three to five years and course codes must be changed.

Resolution No. 8: Course codes of papers must be changed. A senior Controller of Examinations of sister universities should be invited by the Examination Branch to interact the faculty members.

Resolution No. 16: Such type of cases may be decided after considering by Equivalency Committee.

Resolution No. 36: The action taken report has not been confirmed by the Council as Prof. S.K. Sinha already submitted a representation against the action taken against him.

Resolution No. 44: The topics of Ph.D. Scholars may be reviewed through DRC with consultation of Prof. D.P.S. Verma, Member of Academic Council and the Vice-Chancellor is authorized to approve the same.

3. Resolved that the above proposal be approved.

39. Considered and approve recommendations of Inspection Committee for granting Provisional affiliation to J.B.M. College of Education, Village-Shadipur, P.O. Julana, District-Jind-126102 to run B.A.-B.Ed. four year integrated course with 50 seats (1 Unit) from the Academic Session 2020-21.

Resolved that the above recommendations of the Inspection Committee be approved and recommended to the Executive Council.

40. To consider and approve the panels of subject experts to be nominated on the selection Committees for selection on teaching posts including the staff of library subject to approval by the Chancellor as per clause 2 of Statute 24 of the University Act.

Resolved that the Vice-Chancellor is authorized to update the existing panels and/or prepare new panels of subject experts for selection of Teaching/Library posts in various Departments so as to send for the approval of the Chancellor, the matter being confidential.

the subject concerned under clause 2(iv) of Statute 30 of University Act, 2014 without preparing the seniority list of teachers of the affiliated colleges in case of Education Colleges.

Resolved that the action taken by the Vice-Chancellor be Noted and recommended to the Executive Council.

44. Considered and approve the recommendations of the Committee constituted by the Vice-Chancellor for granting special mercy chance to all those students of B.Ed, M.Ed., D.P.Ed., B.P.Ed., M.P.Ed courses who have not completed their degrees in permissible period.

Resolved that the above recommendations of the Committee be approved.

45. Considered and approve the recommendations of the committee constituted by the Vice-Chancellor to take a comprehensive view for exempting the subject Science & Technology in Pre-colonial India not taught in previous sessions 216-18, 2017-19 in M.A. History 1st semester.

Resolved that the above recommendations of the Committee be approved.

46. Considered and approve the recommendations of the PGBOS&R in Department of Music & Dance of CRSU, Jind held on 01.01.2020 regarding increasing of seats in Music Vocal from 10 to 15 and to change the nomenclature of the Department from Department of Music and Dance to Department of Music.

Resolved that the intake of Music Vocal be increased from 10 to 15 and the Chairperson of the department may check the UGC website in respect of change of nomenclature then report to the Academic Council.

47. Considered and approve the following:

- (i) that the recommendations of Sub Committee of AC on the Inspection reports in respect of Education Colleges affiliated to this University submitted by various committees for continuation/extension of provisional affiliation for the Academic Session 2019-20.

The Vice-Chancellor informed the house about the following matters discussed in the meeting of Haryana State Higher Education Council held on 15.01.2020 at M.D.U, Rohtak.

- i) **Whether that the University may follow the Calendar Year or Academic Year or Financial Year?**

The General consensus was to follow Academic Year for Academic Planning etc.

- ii) that the University may implement five days or six days in a week in teaching departments as well as in Colleges?

The General consensus was to follow five Days week.

- iii) that the University may engage at least two Professionals/ Subject Experts may not having NET also, but having language proficiency and knowledge of IT for conducting short term courses to prepare the students for livelihood earning skills, basic IT skills, character building and personality development and competitive competency enhancement.
- iv) that the University may adopt the Students and Teachers exchange programmes in the Universities of State and Centre.
- v) that the University may decide to give marks/credits to the students of Sports, Cultural programme and NSS/NCC participation.
- vi) that the University may create separate Budget for Research Foundation Centre for advanced learning funded by Centre/State Government.

Resolved that the University may initiate the above proposals.

Further resolved that:

1. Dr. Sonu, Chairperson of Economics may collect the information of NET/JRF qualified students from each department and put up the same before the Vice-Chancellor.
2. Academic Audit for the session 2019-20 be conducted.
3. Book Bank may issue the books to the students for full semester and this work be got checked by Dr. Ajmer Singh.
