Sub: - Instruction regarding organization of Inter College Tournament, Section of student players for University Coaching Camp/Team for the session 2021-2022.

Madam/Sir,

In order to organize Inter College Tournaments/Championships, Coaching Camps etc for the session 2021-2022, you are requested to please follow the following instruction.


1. There is no change in the eligibility rules for participation of the students/players in Inter College & Inter University tournaments in the session 2021-2022. In case of any doubt about the eligibility of a player, the undersigned may be consulted. It is also being informed that it will be whole responsibility of the Principal/Director of the College/Institute regarding fake participation/fake documents or if a student player is allowed to participate as member of the College/Institute's team while he/she does not full-fill all the eligibility conditions as per AIU Amended Rules (copy attached for kind perusal) as all the documents on the basis of which the players has/have been admitted are with the Colleges/Institutions.
2. Eligibility proformas of Inter College Tournaments/Championship should be neat clean and legible and preferably typed. Name of the player, Mother's name, Father's date of birth should be the same as given in the matriculation/10+2 certificates and all the decrements must be signed the Principal/Director of the College/Institute concerned.
3. For participation of a player in Inter College/Inter University tournaments/Championship following documents of the players will have to be submitted to the Organising Secretary of the Tournament/Championship.
 - i. Attested copy of Matriculation Certificate (to determine Date of Birth)
 - ii. Attested copy of 10+2 Certificate (for the players studying in U.G. Classes)
 - iii. Attested copy of 10+2 and Graduation (for the players in P.G Classes)
 - iv. ~~Only Computerized prepared Eligibility Proforma duly filled-in-all respect Identity Cards of the participating players will be accepted.~~
 - v. ~~Medical Fitness Certificate duly issued by the registered MBBS Doctor Practitioner~~
 - vi. ~~Copy of the Aadhar Card of the participant~~
4. The principal (Organising Secretary) of the Inter College Tournaments/Championship will be entirely responsible for the successful organization of a Tournaments allotted to the College/Institution and within 4 days after the completion of the tournament/championship, the Organising Secretary will arrange to submit following documents (relating to the Tournaments) to this office i.e. office of the Secretary Sports

Council CRSU, Jind so that Certificates of Merit may be issued to the position holder student players without any delay:-

- i. Result/Organising Secretary Report of the Tournament/Championship dully filled in all respect (Performa A along with Proforma B available on the website of the University inside sports).
 - ii. Eligibility particulars of the participating colleges/Institutions
 - iii. Identity cards of the participating players.
 - iv. Score Sheets of the matches/events duly verified by the Referee/Judge/Team scorer etc.
 - v. Aadhar Card of the participating players.
5. In case a college/Instruction wishes to withdraw its college team from a particular Inter College Tournament/Championship, then the concerned college/Institution will inform to the Organising Secretary of the Tournaments at least three days before the commencement of the tournaments and a copy of the same will have to be sent to this office also.

**Sub. Eligibility Rules for participation in National University Games for
the year 2020-21 onwards.**

Dear All,

Greetings from AIU!

In compliance of the judgment dated September 10, 2021 of the Hon'ble High Court of Kerala In WP (C) No.18554 of 2021, it is hereby directed that those Universities conducting All India/Zonal Inter University Championships/University Championships in any scheduled events for and from the year 2020-21 onwards may permit the participation of students between the age group of 17 and 25 years, **by excluding the criteria splitting up the 8 years period by and between graduate and post graduate courses/studies as mentioned in Clause 4 of the Revised Eligibility Rules dated 28.07.2017.**

Hence, all member universities of AIU are hereby directed to upload the circular on their official website and also disseminate the same to your affiliated colleges for information of all the stakeholders.

Subject: Revised Eligibility Rules for participation of students/athletes in National University Games:2017-18 onwards.

1. The matter with regard to revised Eligibility Rules was considered and discussed thread-bare in the meeting. Sports Board decided to adopt and approve the decision of International University Sports Federation (FISU), regarding the amendment/change in "Age Limit" for participation of student athletes in FISU sporting competitions from 2017-18 onwards. Accordingly, the new approved "Age Limit" from 17 to 25 years shall be applicable for participation of Indian Universities contingent/teams in all the sporting events, including the discipline of Basketball organized by the FISU.
2. Lot of queries have been pouring in AIU office from the member universities regarding Revised Eligibility Rules as these are mandatory for the purpose of admission and selection of teams for participation at zonal and Inter Zonal(National) tournaments.
3. Further, it was also decided to implement the above Age limit from 17 to 25 years alongwith existing "eligibility conditions" put in place for participation of bonafide and full time (regular) students, for participation in National University Games from 2017-18 onwards alongwith following additional terms and conditions:
 - Age limit of the students shall be minimum 17 years and maximum upto 25 years
 - Only a bonafide, full time student, who is enrolled for a course of the University, which is of a minimum duration of one academic year, and whose examination is conducted by the university, shall be eligible to participate in the Inter-University tournaments.
 - Students of open Universities shall be considered to be bonafied students and shall be eligible to participate provided they fulfil other conditions.
 - Ph.D., M. Phil., Compartment, etc. students will be eligible to participate only if in terms of the concerned university rules they are regarded to be bonafide students and fulfil other conditions laid down in this behalf. All students participating in the Inter University Tournaments shall fulfil the following conditions:
 - Not more than 8 years have elapsed since a student passed the examination qualifying him/her for first admission to a university or college affiliated to a university. The 8 year period mentioned above shall be distributed as below:-
 - i. not more than 5 years after passing 10+2 or equivalent while pursuing graduate courses/studies.
4. Accordingly, a copy of Revised Eligibility Rules is uploaded on our website www.aiu.ac.in for advance information and necessary action of all the stakeholders. Further, a copy of the same is being circulated to all member universities for advance information of all the stakeholders in due course of time.

ii. Not more than 3 years after passing Graduation or equivalent while pursuing post graduate course/studies. Irrespective of any other conditions like change of class/course/faculty, joining lower class from higher, changing academic to professional courses or vice versa, provided that students admitted, after passing +2 examination, to graduate courses of more than 3 years duration like Medical, Engineering, Agriculture, Pharmacy etc. shall be eligible to participate in the Inter-University tournaments for the actual length of such graduate courses/studies.

- Only students, who are less than 25 years of age as on first July of the academic year in which the tournament is held, can participate.
- Students shall not be full-time employees of Public or Private sector as the case may be.
- A student shall not be allowed to represent more than one University during a single academic year.
- Provisional admission to a course or University shall not make the student eligible to represent the University.
- In case of a student migrating from one University to another, his/her migration case will be considered eligible only after his/her admission in the new university is regularized and he/she is admitted as a bonafide student by the new university.
- No Objection Certificate (NOC) is mandatory to be eligible for participation for those students, who received or receiving stipend/financial support for pursuing excellence in competitive sports as career from Public or Private Sector to support their studies, as the case may be.

Note: As per existing practice, the comments and queries with regard to the Revised Eligibility Rules received from member universities, if any, will be reported to the next Sports Board Meeting for consideration.
