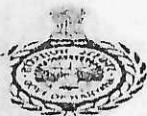

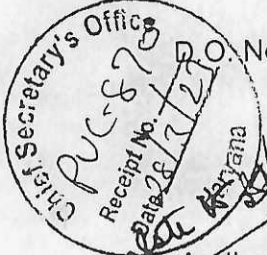

It has come to the notice of the Department that cyber criminals are misusing Aadhaar Enabled Payment System (AePS) to conduct financial frauds, as the system allows any user to deposit cash, withdraw cash, transfer fund and check statements using Aadhaar number and Biometrics.

2. As per information received from Indian Cybercrime Coordination Centre, Ministry of Home Affairs, analysis of Modus Operandi of AePS cyber financial frauds, reveal that biometrics information along with the Aadhaar number uploaded on State's Registry websites (registration of various deeds like Sale Deed, Agreement to Sale, etc.) are downloaded by the criminals, which is then further 'cloned' to carry out unauthorized withdrawals using AePS. In view of such possible cyber frauds, Revenue and Registration Authorities may take immediate steps to mask the finger prints on the documents which are available in public domain. However, the documents that are given to the concerned parties may be unmasked to make it legally acceptable.

3. Therefore, to check and curb the menace of cyber frauds, it is necessary that States/UTs identify such portals where biometrics information, especially thumb prints and Aadhaar number are put in public domain and to take down such documents having fingerprints or blur or mask such biometrics available in public domain within a shortest span of time, not later than in 10 days. Similarly, your kind attention is directed towards regulation 6(3) "Restriction on sharing, circulating or publishing of Aadhaar Number" under The Aadhaar (Sharing of Information) Regulations, 2016 which prohibits displaying Aadhaar numbers unless it has been redacted/blacked out. Therefore, along with biometrics, Aadhaar numbers must be masked or redacted e.g. xxxx xxxx 1234.

4. I shall be extremely grateful if you could look in to the matter personally and direct the concerned officer(s) to do the needful as indicated in para 3 above and get a compliance report sent to me @ jslr-dolr@nic.in or @ prasad-upsc@gov.in.
