A candidate who has passed Senior Secondary Certificate Examination (10+2 Standard) of the Board of School Education, Haryana; or any other examination recognized as equivalent thereto with English as one of the subjects, shall be eligible to join First Semester of the UG Programme.

*The ITI pass outs (with English qualified as additional subject at 10+2 level) are also eligible for seeking admission in First Semester of the UG Programme (Level 5) with Humanities/Social Science subject necessary relaxation in the pass percent will be provided for eligibility as per Haryana Government rules prevailing from time to time.

A candidate who has been placed under compartment or allowed to re-appear in one subject only in Senior Secondary Certificate Examination (10+2 Standard) of the Board of School Education, Haryana, or equivalent examination of another Board may be allowed to study provisionally for the First Semester of the UG Programme. Such a candidate shall clear the compartment/re-appear subject before commencement of the examination of 1st semester of the concerned UG Programme of the University.

For such candidates the required percentage of marks for admission shall be determined by taking into account the minimum pass marks in compartment/re-appear subject.

Important Note: A candidate having compartment in more than one subject in his/her qualifying examination will not be eligible for admission in any programme.

CRITERIA FOR PREPARING MERIT FOR ADMISSION OF PROGRAMS

1.	10+2	:	70% of the percentage of marks obtained.
2.	10 th	:	20% of the percentage of marks obtained.

WEIGHTAGES FOR THE PURPOSE OF ADMISSION

Maximum Weightage of 10 marks only can be claimed from the following points.

A.	Recipients of National Talent Award from the NCERT	5marks
B.	Candidates who have secured 60% marks /CGPA 6.0 on 10 point scale in all previous examinations (10 th & 12 th).	5marks
C.	N.C.C. Cadets who have passed the 'B' Certificate and N.C.C. Cadets who have passed 'C' or 'G-II' Certificate (No Weightage will be given for civil defense service)	3marks
	Note: If NCC cadets have both 'B' and 'C' Certificates maximum Weightage of 5 marks will be given. OR Holder of Certificate of Merit for N.S.S. awarded by the Board.	5marks

Note:

- For allowing weightage to NSS, the certificate should be got verified from the office of the concerned department.
- For allowing weightage to Sports, certificate should be got verified from the Office of the DSO and Assistant Education Officer (AEO) (except State & National Certificate). The certificate should not be older than 3 years.
