1. Convocation for conferment of the following degrees will be held on Monday, May 27th, 2024 at 10:30 A.M at Maharishi Patanjali Yogshala on the University Campus, Jind.

2. Candidates who are eligible to obtain their Degree at the Convocation will conform to the following conditions:

- (A) All the Candidates will obtain duly certified Identification Cards from the Chairperson of the Department concerned, on 26th May 2024 upto 01:00 P.M.
(B) All the Candidates must wear the Convocation dress as specified below:

Dress for Men

Full Sleeves white shirt. Navy Blue Trousers, Black Belt, Black Shoes with white socks.

For Girls:

- Cream colour Sarees with sky blue border.
- Cream colour blouse with half sleeves.
- Black Shoes/sandals and white socks.

- Cream Colour Kameej with sky blue border.
- Cream Colour Salwar.
- Sky blue Dupatta.

Black shoes/sandals and white socks.

OR

Full sleeves white shirt.

Navy Blue Trousers.

Black belt.

Black shoes with white socks.

Registration for Convocation

(For Ph. D Degree Holders) Stole: Sky Blue Khadi Silk or Khadi with Golden Lining (Two University Logos)	Candidates are required to must register themselves through online Registration link. They will collect their prescribed Stoles with University insignia from their respective Departments/Registration Desk/Academic Costumes Kit Committee by submitting/showing their registration form alongwith fee receipt of Rs. 200/- on account of Registration to Convocation to be paid through only payment gateway at the online Registration page.
(For Master/Graduate Degree Holders) Stole: Sky Blue Khadi Silk or Khadi with Silver Lining (Two University logos)	

- All candidates must attend the Compulsory Rehearshal on 26th May 2024 at 02:00 P.M in the Maharishi Patanjali Yogshala, University Campus failing which they will not be allowed to participate in the Convocation.

Note:


A candidate, who does not bring with him/her the Identification Card, duly certified by the concerned Chairperson of the Department and/or does not attend the Rehearsal on 26th May 2024 at 02:00 P.M, will not be allowed to attend the Convocation.

- A candidate who is eligible for conferment of the degree, but does not intend to appear at the Convocation in person can obtain his/her degree in accordance with procedure laid down. **Such a candidate will make a request and will collect their degree from the concerned Chairperson of University Teaching Department, CRSU, Jind alongwith a fee of Rs. 200/- to be paid through online mode in University account or with University Cashier (Accounts Branch) to obtain degee in Absentia.**

SPECIAL INSTRUCTION FOR THE CANDIDATES AND MEDALISTS

- Rehearsal Day 26.05.2024** **Time: 02:00 P.M**
(Recipient degrees are required to reach in the Maharishi Patanjali Yogshala, CRSU, Jind upto 01:40 P.M)
- Convocation: 27.05.2024**
Recipients of Degrees and Medals to occupy their seats by 09:30 A.M.
- Candidates who are to receive the Degrees/Medals at the Convocation are requested to:
 - be punctual for Rehearsal as well as the Convocation;

- (ii) enter the Maharishi Patanjali Yogshala, CRSU, Jind with Identification Card on Convocation Day, with proper dress as specified above at Serial II;
 - (iii) occupy their seats by 9:30 A.M. on Convocation ;
 - (iv) observe silence and proper decorum while in the Hall;
 - (v) remain in their seat during Rehearsal and Convocation proceedings;
 - (vi) ensure that they do not block the passages-either by standing or by walking to and fro;
 - (vii) ensure correct seats Note **the Row No. and Seat No.** allotted on the Rehearsal Day and remember neighbouring students on left and right;
 - (viii) ensure that they have signed the Roll-Call sheets on Rehearsal Day otherwise they will not get their Degrees at the Convocation.
 - (ix) Keep their mobile phones on silent phone.
4. Ph. D Candidates will line up near the dais in batches, in their turns, and will receive their degrees from the Chancellor, Degrees to all other candidates will be distributed on their seats, in their turns, by the University officials on duty.
 5. After receiving the Degrees, candidates are requested to bow to the Chancellor/Vice-Chancellor before taking their seats.
 6. In case of any discrepancy in the Degree awarded, the candidate (s) will meet the Superintendent (Results) after the Convocation is over. The discrepancy need not pointed out during the Convocation, as that may cause unnecessary disturbance in the proceedings of the Convocation.
 7. All the candidates for the award of the Degrees and Medals will stand in their seats:
 - (i) Until the procession of the Chancellor, Vice-Chancellor, members of the various Bodies of the University and other dignitaries enter in the Maharishi Patanjali Yogshala and occupy their seats.
 - (ii) When National Anthem is being played;
 - (iii) No one should leave Maharishi Dayannd Yogshala until the procession has left.
 8. The candidates are not allowed to use cameras/mobiles during the convocation and will have to switch off or keep their mobiles on silent mode.
 9. No candidate will leave the Maharsihi Patanjali Yogshala during the proceedings of the Convocation.
 10. No candidate will touch feet of Hon' ble Chancellor/Vice-Chancellor/Chief Guest during award of Degree.
