MINUTES OF THE 41ST (EMERGENT) MEETING OF THE EXECUTIVE COUNCIL HELD ON 20TH NOVEMBER, 2025 AT 10:30 A.M. ONWARDS IN THE CONFERENCE HALL, TEACHING BLOCK-II, CHAUDHARY RANBIR SINGH UNIVERSITY, JIND UNDER THE CHAIRPERSONSHIP OF VICE-CHANCELLOR.

At the very outset, Prof. (Dr.) Ram Pal Saini, Vice-Chancellor welcomed all the distinguished members of the Executive Council. Thereafter, Prof. Loveleen Mohan, Registrar-cum- Secretary presented the agenda of the meeting sequentially.

THE MINUTES OF THE MEETING ARE AS UNDER:

1. To consider and decide upon the minutes of meeting of the Committee held on 06.11.2025 at 12:30 P.M. constituted to look into the recruitment process and recommend further course of action.

The Executive Council considered the minutes of the committee (held on 06.11.2025 at 12:30 P.M.) constituted to look into the recruitment process and to recommend further action.

After detailed deliberation, the following was resolved by the Executive Council:

- (i) Teaching posts advertised through Advt. Nos. 12/2023 to 16/2023, 20/2023, 24/2023, 26/2023 to 28/2023, 30/2023, 32/2023 to 40/2023, 42/2023 and 44/2023 to 47/2023 be withdrawn and application fee be refunded to applicants.

- (ii) Teaching posts advertised vide Advt. No. 43/2023 had already been withdrawn by University vide Notification No. CRSU/REG./2024/4998 dated 12.02.2024. The application fee of this advertisement be refunded to applicants.
- (iii) The House noted that for the post advertised vide Advt. Nos. 17/2023 to 19/2023, 21/2023 to 23/2023, 25/2023, 29/2023 and 41/2023, the meetings of the Selection Committee were conducted in the year 2024 and the recommendations of the Committee are lying under sealed envelopes. It was further observed that in respect of the post advertised vide Advt. No. 06/2020 (Assistant Professor, Physics), the meeting of the Selection Committee was held in the year 2021 and the recommendations of the Committee also are lying under sealed envelope. Since some of the applicants have approached the Hon'ble High Court of Punjab and Haryana, and the matter is sub judice, the posts, advertised through the aforementioned advertisements may not be considered for withdrawal at this stage. Further course of action shall be decided after the status of the pending court cases is decided.

The House was informed that as per committee recommendations dated 06.11.2025, the University has sought Legal Advice from Advocate General of Haryana. The House further resolved to authorize the Vice-Chancellor to proceed in the matter as per the legal opinion obtained from the office of the Advocate General, Haryana, and to report the same to the Executive Council.

Furthermore, the House resolved that the University may initiate the recruitment process by re-advertising the posts recommended for withdrawal under point no. (i) and (ii) above. Roster points for these posts be prepared as per the latest SOPs issued by the State Government.

2. Any other Item (s):

- (i) The Vice-Chancellor apprised the House that the Department of Law was established by the University in the Academic Session 2022-2023, offering three programmes, namely LL.M (Two Year), B.A. LL.B (Hons.) Five Year and LL.B (Hons.) Three Year. The University has requested the State Government for sanction of budgeted teaching posts; however, the approval is still awaited. Consequently, no sanctioned teaching posts presently exist in the Department of Law. Due to acute shortage of teaching faculty, the students are facing difficulties in meeting their academic requisites.

In view of the above, the Vice-Chancellor proposed that the University may invite applications from either serving or superannuated senior teachers (Professor/Associate Professor) on deputation, contract, or any other permissible mode to ensure smooth academic functioning of the Department.

The House considered and deliberated upon the proposal in detail. In view of students' welfare, it was resolved that the Vice-Chancellor be authorized to constitute a committee to frame appropriate rules/regulations for the purpose, keeping in view the financial viability and other relevant norms.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair.
